# Ocean Commotion

# Lesson #5

Age: 3rd Grade



# Objective:

- Students will write to communicate ideas and information effectively.
- Students will understand the nature and power of language.

#### Materials:

Ocean Commotion by Julie Woik
Pencils or Pens and Markers, Crayons, or Colored Pencils
Paper (letter/legal/ledger) on which to draw their town.
Print out form that correlates with this lesson.
Optional - Send home letter to parents regarding this lesson.
See attached Letter for Parents

## Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read Ocean Commotion, showing everyone the detailed illustrations. After the reading, have the students dream up their OWN town and illustrate it on a large piece of paper. Then have them write up dialog for a TV commercial that will "sell" the town to potential new residents. Students can refer to the worksheet for ideas as to what they might want to include in their ad.

### Assessment:

Students learn to write for a particular audience or purpose. They will recognize that language formality varies according to the situation or particular audience base. They will understand that word choices can shape perception.
