### Materials:

Ocean Commotion book by Julie Woik Plain Frisbee (can often find at the various Dollar Stores) Colored Markers or Paint (quick drying) Foam Shapes, Stickers, Letters/Numbers, or any other sort of Decorations that can be added to Frisbee without making it off balance Ocean Theme Stickers or Decorations

#### Discover:

Read Ocean Commotion together. Discuss how Echo innocently took items that she wanted, but didn't really think about how everyone else would feel about that. Discover the feeling of having someone take something of yours without asking, paying for it, or having it given to them as a gift.

## Activity:

- Place the Frisbee onto the table.
- Pick out some fun stickers, letters, or even some numbers that might mean something to you.
- Place them on the Frisbee where you'd like them to be. Move stuff around if it's not laying out right. You may change your mind a few times. Check out all of the stickers and so forth before you place them on permanently.

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## Take Action:

After clean up, have the child/children discuss the importance of someone paying for items they want. Talk about how everyone is human, and sometimes we make mistakes. If they have ever found themselves in a situation in which honesty was needed, discuss what the best plan of action would be. Have the child fill in what they would do under the various situations presented on *Fly High Fly Right* sheet.
