### Objective:

- Students will understand what makes a plural noun.
- Students will be able identify plural nouns with the help of visual supports.
- Students will begin to use plural spellings correctly when writing sentences.

### Materials:

The Little Building by Julie Woik

Pencils, Colors, Markers, or Color Pencils

Print out form that correlates with this lesson.

Optional - Send home letter to parents regarding this lesson.

### Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read The Little Building, showing everyone the illustrations. After the reading, hand out the activity and have the students circle the correct spelling for the plural of that noun. They may need to do this activity a couple of times to get them right, but they'll begin to recognize that plural spellings are sneaky sometimes!!!

### Assessment:

Students will begin to recognize the way certain words become plural. The English language can be tricky, so repetition of this activity will help drive home the lesson regarding the ending of a noun and how that affects the plural spelling.
