Lesson #3

Age:

1st Grade

Objective:

- Students will learn what components are used to make a declarative sentence.
- Students will determine how to put words in the correct order in a sentence.

Materials:

The Little Building by Julie Woik
Pencils, Colors, Markers, or Color Pencils
Print out form that correlates with this lesson.
Optional - Send home letter to parents regarding this lesson.

Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read The Little Building, showing everyone the illustrations. After the reading, talk about simple declarative sentences, which make a statement and use a period at the end. Then hand out the form for this activity and have the students figure out which sentence is put together in the correct order.

Assessment:

Students will recognize simple sentence structure and improve their reading comprehension.
