Lesson #1



Age:
Kindergarten

Objective:

- Students will recognize the name the months in a year.
- Students will be able to put the months of the year in order, count how many months there are in a year, and identify the month before and after a given month.

Materials:

The Little Building by Julie Woik

Colors, Markers, or Color Pencils

Print out form that correlates with this lesson.

Optional - Send home letter to parents regarding this lesson.

Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read *The Little Building*, showing everyone the illustrations. After the reading, review the months of the year. Then hand out the form that goes with this activity. Have the students connect the dots to put the months in the correct order. Discuss the importance of dates and how we often have to do things in a timely manner.

Assessment:

Students will learn the order in which each month falls in the year. They'll begin to understand how the months on the calendar affect our schedules and fit into our daily lives.
